OPENING STATEMENT FROM VCU Head Coach Stiffler

"It was a good ballgame. A lot of credit to Oregon State and again to the depth and the quality of their arms, and the depth and quality of the arms in this regional are stunning at times. I am really proud of our guys and thought we did a real nice job with their starter. When he gave us pitches to hit, we were on attack mode, and that started from the first inning. We were ready to go. And then from there, it was about Heath Dwyer. He did outstanding tonight and was able to keep them off balance. And then we were able to hand it over to Danny Concepcion and he threw his final eight outs. Exciting night for VCU to be sitting up here with these two seniors, and what they have met to this program and to be 2-0 in the regional, A-10 champs, is kind of a surreal moment for me."

Coach Stiffler highlight quotes

What is the mindset coming into tomorrow's championship game?

"We have to take this thing one game at a time. We are not looking ahead at the Super Regional or anything like that. There are two very good baseball teams left in this tournament, and whoever we get to play tomorrow, we will have our work absolutely cut out for us. Tomorrow will be the most challenging baseball that any of us have played in our lives."

With the day off Saturday, how much do you think it helped the team?

"You know I think a little bit obviously, got our two bullpen arms a little bit of a break. We were able to get them back. I can tell you though, yesterday I wanted to play. We were coming off a big win on Friday night, and I think these guys wanted to play and we didn't want to sit around

the hotel. So I don't know if it helped or not, but I am very proud of them keeping their edge and being able to play and ready to go."

Heath Dwyer

Can you explain over the past 10 day span, starting from winning the A-10 tournament, and to where you are now; how you have been able to build success after success and be in this position to possibly enter a Super Regional?

"We put our backs in a corner a little bit. With a couple weeks left at the end of the season, we needed to start winning, and we did. We stepped up our game and just got on a roll. From a defensive standpoint, how important was it to turn those big double plays and know defensively that you can make those when they matter several times throughout the day?
